On Friday, February 5, 2010, Advanced Agri-Solutions Co-op, Inc. and Southwest Landmark, Inc. held separate special meetings to conduct the tallying of Member votes on the proposed Agreement and Plan of Consolidation that was included in the notice of this meeting.

The Teller Committee for Advanced Agri-Solutions Co-op, Inc., comprised of Mark Cisco, CPA, Tom Dickman, Jim Holthaus and Ken Ankerman, met at 10:00 a.m. at the corporation's headquarters in Wapakoneta, Ohio.

The Teller Committee for Southwest Landmark, Inc. comprised of Charles Borton, Mike Curry, Ron Harbage and Charlie Neff, met at 10:00 a.m. at the corporation's headquarters in Xenia, Ohio.

We are pleased to report that the Agreement and Plan of Consolidation was approved by both Membership bases. Advanced Agri-Solutions had a 77.1 percent passing rate with a total of 1,294 ballots received. Southwest Landmark had an 82 percent passing rate with a total of 632 ballots received. The consolidation will become effective September 1, 2010 under the new company name of Trupointe Co-op, Inc. Larry Hammond will assume the position as president and CEO and Gordon Wallace will assume the position as Chief Operating Officer.

On behalf of both Board of Directors', we thank you for your support of our co-op and of our business decision. We are confident that as we move into the future, this consolidation will place us with strengths and advantages that can be rivaled by few. We look forward to continuing to serve you and becoming part of the Trupointe Co-op family.
